The successful candidate will be responsible for all aspects of HS&E strategic planning as it relates, but not limited to, policy, emerging trends and issues, systems and standards/regulatory compliance. Candidate will be required to provide “in the field” leadership and guidance in HS&E risk management to all trades related to electrical distribution at all designated locations.
